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| 10. Gremillet Brut Sélection Champagne NV
A full, creamy Champagne, broad and biscuity on the palate with clean acidity on the finish. | 32.50 |
| 11. Gremillet Brut Rosé Champagne NV
Delightful salmon pink fizz with delicate fruit from a small family-owned Champagne House of 20ha in the heart of Les Riceys. | 37.50 |
| 12. Laurent Perrier Brut LP NV
A delicate and complex nose with aromas of citrus fruit, this is a full flavoured Champagne with a subtle creaminess and good balance. | 45.00 |
| 13. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut NV
The classic Grand Marque with its instantly recognisable yellow label, originally designed by Madame Clicquot is rich in flavour and yet light and refreshing. | 52.00 |
| 14. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rose Brut NV
Made solely from pinot noir, this champagne gets its glorious pink colour and rounded red fruit flavours from a process known as 'saignée' in which the skins are left in contact with the juice. Wonderfully fresh with a suppleness on the palate and a lingering finish. | 75.00 |
| 15. Dom Pérignon Vintage 1999
This stunning champagne is named after Dom Pérignon regarded by many as the inventor of Champagne. An absolutely delicious wine from a brilliant vintage. | 150.00 |

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SPARKLING WINE

SPAIN

- 18. Codorniu Clásico Brut NV Cava** 17.95
A classic Cava produced using traditional grape varieties with the addition of Chardonnay and then bottle aged for eighteen months. Crisp and elegant with a warm ripe finish.

AUSTRALIA

- 19. Green Point Méthode Traditionelle Brut NV** 24.95
Moet in Australia. Chardonnay blended with Pinot Noir to produce a wonderfully fresh style with subtle fruit favours and a creamy palate.

ENGLAND

- 20. Denbies Whitedowns Cuvée Brut 2004** 32.50
From Englands largest vineyard, this vintage Cuvée is crisp and vibrant with a delicate refreshing finish.

WHITE WINES

LOIRE

- 21. Vouvray Clos de Nouys Sec 2004** 26.95
From an eight hectare single vineyard in the commune of Vouvray this wine exhibits aromas of quince and fresh flowers.
- 22. Sancerre Domaine Michel Girard & Fils 2007** 28.50
Deliciously dry with a pungent bouquet and wonderful length.

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BURGUNDY

- 23. Chablis Cuvée André Domaine des Malandes 2006** 27.95
Classic, flinty dry Chablis with just a hint of fruit.
- 24. Mercurey Blanc Domaine Juillot 2003** 39.95
From the top Estate in Mecurey, Michel Juillot produces a style that is both stylish and refined.
- 25. Pouilly Fuissé Dom de Fussiacus Vieilles Vignes 2005** 38.95
Benchmark Pouilly Fuissé with hints of honey and vanilla. Subtle use of oak barrels give this complex wine a long creamy finish.
- 26. Meursault Sous la Velle Domaine Michelot 2005/6** 55.00
Stunning benchmark Meursault with great balance from this meticulous winemaker showing weight but also a fine citrus acidity.

ALSACE

- 27. Turckheim Gewurztraminer Cuvée Réserve 2005/6** 24.50
Rated as one of the best producers in Alsace this reserve wine is complex and dry with hints of spice and lychee fruit.

GERMANY

- 28. Deinhard Riesling Classic 2004/5** 17.50
From a household name respected for quality, this Riesling is well balanced with a fine fruity body and elegant, racy acidity.

ITALY

- 29. Soave Classico Pra 2006** 27.95
Made by Graziano Pra, this Soave has recieved many accolades in past vintages.

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SOUTH AFRICA

- 30. Bouchard Finlayson Sans Barrique Chardonnay 2006** 26.75
Situated in Walker Bay, east of Cape Town, this Estate produces some of the finest Chardonnays in South Africa. This wine is vinified without the use of oak giving it a clean fresh melon character.

AUSTRALIA

- 31. Tyrrell's Old Winery Chardonnay 2005/6** 19.95
Tyrrell's was the producer that introduced us to Australian oaked Chardonnay. This is a prime example of that style, with big ripe tropical fruit flavours and balanced vanilla oak on the finish.
- 32. Trentham Murray River Vignier 2004** 25.95
Formerly a large sheep station, the Estate has been making wine since 1909. This is an exotic wine with intense peachy aromatics and a fresh palate which will work wonderfully with fish and Asian inspired dishes.
- 33. Cape Mentelle Margaret River Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2007** 29.50
The classic Australian white blend made by the winery that started Cloudy Bay. Fresh and zesty with fresh gooseberry and honeydew melon flavours finishing with subtle well-integrated oak.

NEW ZEALAND

- 34. Allan Scott Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2006** 27.95
Stunning fruity wine, intensely flavoured with gooseberries and blackcurrant leaf from Cloudy Bay's next door neighbour.
- 35. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough 2007/8** 39.00
The most famous New World Sauvignon Blanc with the highest of international reputations. Lime, herb and gooseberry flavours with a wonderful zesty finish.
- 36. Cloudy Bay Chardonnay Marlborough 2005** 42.00
From the famous cult winery, this chardonnay is Burgundian in style. A hint of creamy oak gives the wine wonderful depth and flavour.

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UNITED STATES

- 37. Frogs Leap Chardonnay Carneros California 2005** **54.95**
Clean and bright with flavours of apricot, wet stone,
and just a delicate hint of vanilla.

CHILE

- 38. Sauvignon Blanc Vina Carmen 2008** **15.95**
A crisp Sauvignon with a vibrant grassy character and hints of tropical fruits.

ROSÉ WINES

- 39. Ch. La Moutete Rosé Côtes du Provence 2007** **22.95**
This is an elegant wine with a light salmon pink colour and gentle
floral aromas with hints of nectarine and redcurrant.

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RED WINES

BORDEAUX

- 40. Château de Balan Bordeaux 2005** 19.95
An easy drinking classic Bordeaux style with soft cassis fruit and fine balance.
- 41. Château des Gravières Graves 2004** 28.95
An unusual blend from the Left Bank, with 90% Merlot, barrel matured with soft oak flavours and a chalky edge.
- 42. Clos de la Cure St Emilion Grand Cru 2004** 36.50
A rich, dense wine with real elegance from the same gravel and clay soil structure as Château Cheval Blanc fruit.
- 43. Château Malescot St Exupéry 3ème Cru Classé Margaux 2001** 72.50
This estate has been producing stylish, higher-quality wines over the last few years, making quintessentially elegant, suave, gracefully constructed wines typical of Margaux.
- 44. Château Quinault L'Enclos Saint-Émilion Grand Cru 1999** 86.95
Unquestionably one of the star estates in St. Emilion with the cult oenologist Michel Rolland acting as a consultant

BEAUJOLAIS

- 45. Beaujolais-Villages Combe aux Jacques Louis Jadot 2006** 19.95
An attractive well balanced, cherry-coloured wine with elegant aromas of strawberries and cherries.
- 46. Fleurie Caves de Fleurie 2006** 23.50
A smooth soft easy drinking style of this wine made from the Gamay grape in Southern Burgundy.

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BURGUNDY

- 47. Beaune Louis Jadot 1999** **38.95**
From a classic vintage this is an elegant wine with red and black fruit aromas and a long soft mellow finish.
- 48. Gevrey-Chambertin Pierre Bourée Fils 2001** **49.95**
A great example from the Cotes de Nuits area: this mature wine from a fabulous vintage displays all the charm you expect from Pinot Noir along with a touch of the rustic tradition.
- 49. Nuits-Saint-Georges 1er Cru Les Boudots Louis Jadot 2000** **79.50**
A single site bordering the premier cru vineyards of Vosne-Romanée producing rich wines with considerable dimension and structure. A real must for all Burgundy lovers.

RHÔNE

- 50. Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Louis Belle Domaine Belle 2004** **36.50**
The premium cuvee from this highly regarded producer is made from parcels of low yielding syrah grapes grown in the famous gravelly Larnage area. Very concentrated with rich, savoury, ripe dark fruit and creamy tannins.
- 51. Châteauneuf-du-Pape Chante Cigale 2005** **39.95**
Seductive and rich, this powerful Chateauneuf is full-flavoured with elements of spice and tobacco yet with a velvety finish.

SOUTHWEST FRANCE

- 52. Château Montus Madiran 2002** **38.95**
From one of the most individually expressive appellations in SW France and the region's most energetic and quality-driven producer. A sweet, pure nose of cassis, black plums, and subtle new oak notes, extraordinarily deep and full-bodied, with layers of concentrated, pure black fruit.

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SPAIN

- 53. Puerta Vieja Crianza Rioja Bodegas Riojanas 2003** 22.95
An attractive style of Rioja with ripe berry fruit, a hint of vanilla oak and a subtle velvety finish.
- 54. Vina Albina Rioja Gran Reserva Bodegas Riojanas 1998** 42.50
Owning some of the best vineyard sites in Rioja, this Bodega has a long standing reputation as a producer of exceptional wines of which this is a classic Gran Reserva from a great vintage.

ITALY

- 55. Villa La Pagliaia Chianti Classico 2004** 24.95
This old estate located in the south of Chianti Classico makes a traditional style of wine with the focus on quality grapes from older vines. Archetypal Chianti: brambly, bitter cherry fruit, cedary with spicy backnotes, succulent acidity and well managed tannins.
- 56. Barolo Dardi Le Rose, Bussia, Poderi Colla 2003** 59.50
A superb example of a classic Barolo: notes of roses and wild berries merge into silky, subtle tannins and a long, lingering finish.

AUSTRALIA

- 57. Tyrrell's Old Winery Cabernet Merlot 2005** 19.95
The classic Bordeaux blend, Australian style with aromas of wild berries and a smooth long elegant finish.
- 58. Mad Fish Pinot Noir Western Australia 2003/4** 24.95
Grapes selected from cool climate vineyards in the Great Southern produce a warm complex wine packed with supple red berry fruit and round gentle tannins from the oak ageing.
- 59. Cape Mentelle Margaret River Shiraz 2002/3** 37.95
The perfect maritime climate and gravel soils of Margaret River make premium wines noted for their distinctive fruit characters. This wine is no exception with complex berry spice and pepper notes.

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NEW ZEALAND

- 60. Saint Clair Merlot Marlborough 2006** **28.50**
Grown on the Saint Clair vineyard "Rapaura" which is one of the warmest in the district ensuring the grapes are fully ripened. Flavours of plums and blackberries dominate with delicate spicy oak.
- 61. Cloudy Bay Pinot Noir Marlborough 2005** **42.00**
Hand picked fruit combined with expertise of this famous winery produces textbook New World Pinot with a rich palate and silky tannins.

SOUTH AFRICA

- 62. Meerlust Red Stellenbosch 2004** **27.95**
A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot produced in limited quantities from the young vines on the historic Meerlust Estate.

CHILE

- 63. Casa Lapostolle Cabernet Sauvignon 2004/5** **25.95**
A World-class wine using French expertise and the superb terroir of Chile.

CHAMPAGNE

64. Gremillet Grand Reserve Brut NV 17.95
A full, creamy Champagne, broad and biscuity on the palate with clean acidity on the finish.

65. Laurent Perrier Brut LP NV 23.95
A delicate and complex nose with aromas of citrus fruit, this is a full flavoured Champagne with a subtle creaminess and good balance.

WHITE

66. Tyrrells Old Winery Chardonnay 2003 11.95
An oak aged Australian wine showing all the hallmark complexity with vanilla and butter flavours.

67. Sancerre Robert et François Crochet 2006 16.95
Deliciously dry with a pungent bouquet and wonderful length.

68. Pouilly Fuissé Domaine Les Vieux Murs 2001 19.75
The best Cru from the Maconnais, full of rich creamy fruit.

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RED

69. **Puerta Vieja Crianza Bodegas Riojanas 2004** 11.95
A fruit driven modern style of Rioja with soft tannins from its oak ageing.
70. **Villa La Pagliaia Chianti Classico 2002** 14.95
Archetypal Chianti: brambly, bitter cherry fruit, cedary with spicy backnotes, succulent acidity and well managed tannins.
71. **Château Ramage la Batisse Cru Bourgeois Haut-Medoc 2000** 19.95
Established in the 18C this Estate makes full round wines from the classic blend. Very authentic Medoc.
72. **Domaine des Sénéchaux Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2003/5** 22.50
Deep ruby/purple in colour, this unfiltered wine has a textured, layered feel and is sexy and seductive in style.

DESSERT WINES

73. **Elysium Black Muscat 2006** 18.95
The Black Muscat grape produces aromas of rose with a rich berry flavour: would partner any chocolate based dessert.
74. **Deen VAT 5 Botrytis Semillon 2005** 19.95
Apricots and honey finishing with a refreshing citrus acidity.
75. **Château de Ste Helene Sauternes Grand Cru Classé 2000** 27.95
A rich honeyed wine with layers of exotic botrytised fruit from younger vines on the prestigious Chateau de Malle estate in the heart of Sauternes.

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
